Topic: Totally Terrific Toys

Visits and Visitors:

We will be visiting Great Cornard Library. We are enquiring about a 'Great fire of London', day!

Art and design:

We will explore different media and markers to create pictures. We will be producing art inspired by our Topic on, 'The Great Fire of London.'

Design Technology

We will be creating and designing our own toy. We will invite parents in for a DT workshop where they will make their own old fashion toys - Cup and ball and Thaumatrope.

Personal, Social, Health and Emotional:

We will look at how we can begin to connect with each other, our class and school community to develop a sense of belonging through team building activities.

Philosophy:

Using the book, 'Have you filled a bucket today', we will discuss making good choices and how we can be 'Bucket fillers.'

Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural:

We will create rules for a safe and calm classroom and think about our Pot Kiln Promise. We will take on responsibilities to help our class run smoothly.

Computing:

Children will learn how to log on and off so they can use 'Bug Club', independently. We will learn how to stay safe online.

Business Initiative:

We will hold a cake sale to fund our school trips and learning experiences.

Learning Together:

Parents: This will be a DT session where you will help your child create a toy.
Children/Peers: We will retell our stories to Year 2 and ask them what they liked and what we could do to improve.



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Maths:

Our focus will be looking at place value to ensure they are secure with numbers 0-10 and 10-20. We will look at number patterns, number recognition counting forwards and backwards and developing addition and subtraction strategies. We will have, 'Investigation Friday's', to encourage problem solving and mathematical language.

English:

Our focus texts will include, 'Oi Frog', and 'The Naughty Bus'. Children will write labels, captions and their own stories. We will be focusing on letter formation and use capital letters and full stops consistently. We will write a recount of the, 'The Great Fire of London'.

MFL:

We will learn basic greetings in french, simple songs and the days of the week.

Music:

We will be learning traditional skipping rhymes and chants and learning about traditional songs our parents and grandparents may have sung. We will learn songs for our Nativity Play!

P.E:

All children will be developing co-ordination skills through movement, dance and Gymnastics. We will be pretending we are in a toy museum that comes to life at night. Children will create a sequence of moves in groups to perform to their friends.



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Learning Outside the

Classroom: All children will have access to the continuous outdoor provision. Children will be creating artwork outside using natural materials.

R.E:

We will all learn about why the word 'God' is important to Christians. We will learn about their beliefs and values and how they are similar or different to other faiths.

History:

We will learn about, 'The Great Fire of London', and the significant events that led to it. Children will explore London both past and present.

Geography:

We will be discovering our local area, looking at key geographical features and some of the different roles people have at work and in our community. We will find out about maps and create our own maps showing our journey to school.

Science:

Our focus will be materials. We will be learning to identify and classify a range of common materials, glass, metal, plastic, fabric and wood. Children will be learning to work scientifically as they make careful observations and carrying out simple tests such as which material will make the best house for the 3 little pigs.
