Areas to consider	Suggested Practice	School Guidance
<p>Learning</p>	<p>Pupils should be kept in class groups for PE.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Agree what learning is appropriate (including the relationship between face-to-face and remote education), for example, identify curriculum priorities, agree revised expectations and required adjustments in practical lessons, and any approaches to 'catch up' support. • Team games which involve contact should be avoided. 	<p>Pupils remain in class/year groups for P.E.</p> <p>Staff to follow P.E curriculum plans. Adapt activities to avoid physical contact. Clearly space pupils and mark working areas.</p> <p><i>Maxim Sports – Ian Frost designated Sports Coach. No other coaches used. For all indoor sessions a face covering must be worn. IF to follow Pot Kiln Risk Assessment and sign visitor agreement/form at office. (RA shared with IF 3.1.21)</i></p> <p>Adapt team games during P.E sessions. Introduce 2 touch and pass and 3 second rules to avoid tackling and contact.</p>
Areas to consider	Suggested Practice	School Guidance
<p>Protective measures and hygiene</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decide the physical and organisational structures needed to limit risks and limit movement around the building(s) (for example, entry and exit points) • Ensure there is sufficient tissues available for ensuring good respiratory hygiene – i.e. 'catch it, bag it, bin it' approach. 	<p>P.E rules to be explained clearly. Each class to use designated entry exit for outside P.E sessions. To use Hall, enter and exit through rear hall door to avoid walking through the school. Pupils spaced out in lines and during input to lesson.</p> <p>Tissues and hand sanitiser to be taken to lesson along with first aid kit and inhalers.</p> <p>Equipment used during session to be returned to kit area and sprayed. Teacher/LSA to return items to store.</p> <p><i>*Ensure equipment is cleaned and put away correctly when used outside of P.E lessons, for example breakout sessions/behaviour support. (3.1.21)</i></p>



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<p>Changing areas</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attending school with PE kit on will limit the need to use changing rooms. • Ensure sufficient standard cleaning equipment is available in all changing areas. • Social distancing measures still apply. 	<p>Pupils to wear school P.E kit on appropriate days. P.E kit expectations set in line with school uniform rules.</p> <p>Changing areas are not to be used.</p> <p>Kit and safe areas marked out during every P.E. session.</p>
Areas to consider	Suggested Practice	School Guidance
<p>Teaching areas</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encourage outdoor PE and PA to support social distancing. • Students should work in their own zone which may be marked out, depending on allocated teaching space. 	<p>PE outside is preferable to indoor PE.</p> <p>Use line marking on KS2 playground and discs on KS1 playground to mark out working areas for pupils.</p>
Areas to consider	Suggested Practice	School Guidance
<p>Group sizes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Class sizes should adhere to Government guidance and be reduced to a level where social distancing rules can be applied 	<p>Risk assess the planned activity and size of the group. Consider splitting activities into smaller groups or rotating stations.</p> <p><i>After school clubs to remain under review (3.1.21)</i></p>



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<p>P.E equipment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equipment will need to be cleaned after each use. • You will need to make a decision on which equipment is easier to build into lessons and take into account the cleaning regime at the end of the sessions. • Hand washing routines will mean more equipment is available to pupils, however it is often easier to plan for and discourage the sharing of equipment to mitigate against virus transmission. 	<p>All P.E equipment to be cleaned after use.</p> <p>Each class responsible for break time equipment: Equipment kept in classroom. Please ensure all equipment collected at the end of break times and cleaned. (3.1.21)</p> <p>Only take necessary equipment. Teacher/LSA to issue equipment and return to kit area for cleaning.</p> <p>Hand washing before and after every P.E lesson. Ensure enough equipment is available to avoid sharing. If this is not possible, equipment to be cleaned between use by another pupil.</p>
Areas to consider	Suggested Practice	School Guidance
<p>Hall area</p>	<p>Avoid unnecessary use of indoor P.E spaces.</p>	<p>The hall should remain a clear space. Any equipment being used should be wiped down after use and put away by the Teacher/LSA.</p> <p>Mark area for kit, safe area and active/working area.</p> <p>Enter and exit via rear hall door.</p> <p>Windows and doors to remain open for ventilation (3.1.21)</p>
