Topic: The Tudors

Visits and Visitors:

We will be organising virtual tour of Kentwell Hall. Depending on COVID restrictions will visit the Gainsborough Museum in Sudbury as part of our Geography topic.

Philosophy:

Philosophy for Children Stories and weekly videos from Mrs Lock. These will help us consider and evaluate our view of the world and our relationships with other people around us. The children will have the opportunity debate their views.

Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural:

Using our Tudor topic as the hook, we will explore Henry 8th and the laws he created during his reign. We will debate the moral, cultural and spiritual impact these had on society.

Art, Design and D.T:

During the first part of the Summer term we will be making collages inspired by 'POP' art. After half we will use the paintings Thomas Gainsborough as our focus and link to our local history topic.

Computing:

We will be looking at coding and programming using an 'Hour of Code.'



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Peer and Collaborative Learning (Children):

Throughout the term we will be developing skills of reflection by using peer and collaborative marking.

Personal, Social, Health and Emotional:

We will be following the school wide topics of 'Capable' and 'Courage.' Using these themes, we will explore personal challenges that demonstrate these qualities.

Learning Together (Parents):

This is dependent on COVID restrictions. More details will be available during the term.



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Maths:

In numeracy we will be following the White Rose scheme to explore decimals, geometry and measurement. We will be using cross curriculum links to help embed these maths skill such as measuring distances and recording times in seconds, tenths and hundredths in athletics.

P.E:

In PE we will be playing Cricket as our team game focus in Summer Term1. After half term we will be covering athletics and linking this to the Olympics in Tokyo.

Learning Outside the Classroom

Learning outside the classroom will take place across the curriculum wherever possible. Biological science will be supplemented by the use of the Grow areas around school.

English:

Our Class read will be 'The Tempest' and this will be the model for our script writing topic. We will cover Diary writing and issues of and racism by learning about the Empire of Windrush in 1948. Finally, using Henry 8th as our historical figure we will complete a unit of writing on biographies.

R.E:

We will be learning about Humanism and the idea that knowledge and feelings are directly linked.



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History:

We will study the Tudor period by looking at famous figures, fashions, foods and discoveries from this time. We will use this learning to build a picture of how life would have been in Sudbury during this period of time. From this understanding we plan to compare to the changes that have occurred to what we see today.

MFL:

We will have a languages day inspired by the Olympics in Tokyo. We will use this to focus on one of the countries competing at the global event.

Science:

In science we will be studying properties of materials and after half term we will be looking at habitats.

Geography:

We will be focusing on local geography and link this to our studies in History. We will use compass points and grid references to find historic building in Suffolk.

Music:

The children will continue with their guitar lessons with Mr. Lockington.
